About Registration

- Please complete **ALL** information requested on the form. **THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT – CAMPERS ARE NOT REGISTERED UNTIL ALL INFORMATION IS RECEIVED. DO NOT SEND INCOMPLETE FORMS.**
- Do not bring extra, registered campers to camp.

About Deposits

- \$50 per person (campers and leaders) for pre-registration deposit. Deposits may be paid in cash or check. (Make checks payable to Pisgah Baptist Church) **Campers are not registered until deposit and completed form is received. Deposit can be made in two payments. First is due on January 17, and the second is due February 7. Deposits are non-refundable.**

SOME THINGS PARENTS, LEADERS, AND CAMPERS ALWAYS WANT TO KNOW:

1. What to bring? First of all bring an expectant heart, a listening ear, and a positive attitude. Also bring your Bible, a small notebook, pillow, linens, blanket, towels, casual clothes, tennis shoes, personal items, swim wear, Beach Towel, sun block. **ALSO, each student should bring a 24 pack case of water.**
2. What about dress codes? All campers dress should reflect a Christ-like example to others. Our key verses concerning clothing and behavior are Romans 12:1-2. Immodestly dressed campers will be discreetly asked by a leader of the same gender to change clothing. We ask that all girls wear a shirt with any tankini or bikini.
3. What about spending money? We will be making stops all through our trip...Teenagers may want to buy snacks then. Students will need to bring money for food on the trip to and from camp. In addition, \$50 is suggested for spending money.
4. What about prescription drugs? All prescription drugs must be checked in to Nikki Albritton. Medication must be in pharmacist labeled bottle with patient name and dosage instructions on it. **Parents, please place medicine in Zip-Lock bag with students name on it.**
5. What to leave at home? Fireworks, firearms, knives, paintball guns, water guns, shaving cream, skates, skateboards, tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, and non-prescription drugs.
6. Can we prank? **ABSOLUTELY NOT!** This thought should never even enter anybody's mind. **NOTICE PARENTS: Pranking will not be tolerated. Parents will be called to come and retrieve their teenager from Harriet, Arkansas. Ephesians 4:29**
7. What about phone use/emergency contacts? Cell phones will be taken up on the bus when we arrive at camp and returned when we leave camp. However we will allow 15 minute calls nightly with students cell phones.
